In Brasilia, delegates are meeting with Brazil's [Minister of Human Rights, Family and Women](#), Damares Alves, the [Speaker](#) of the Federal Senate, Davi Alcolumbre, and a number of members of the National Congress, including those who serve on the foreign affairs committees in the [Federal Senate](#) and the [Chamber of Deputies](#). In addition, they will participate in a roundtable discussion about Indigenous issues. In São Paulo, delegates will meet with business leaders, academics and representatives of civil society organizations.
